

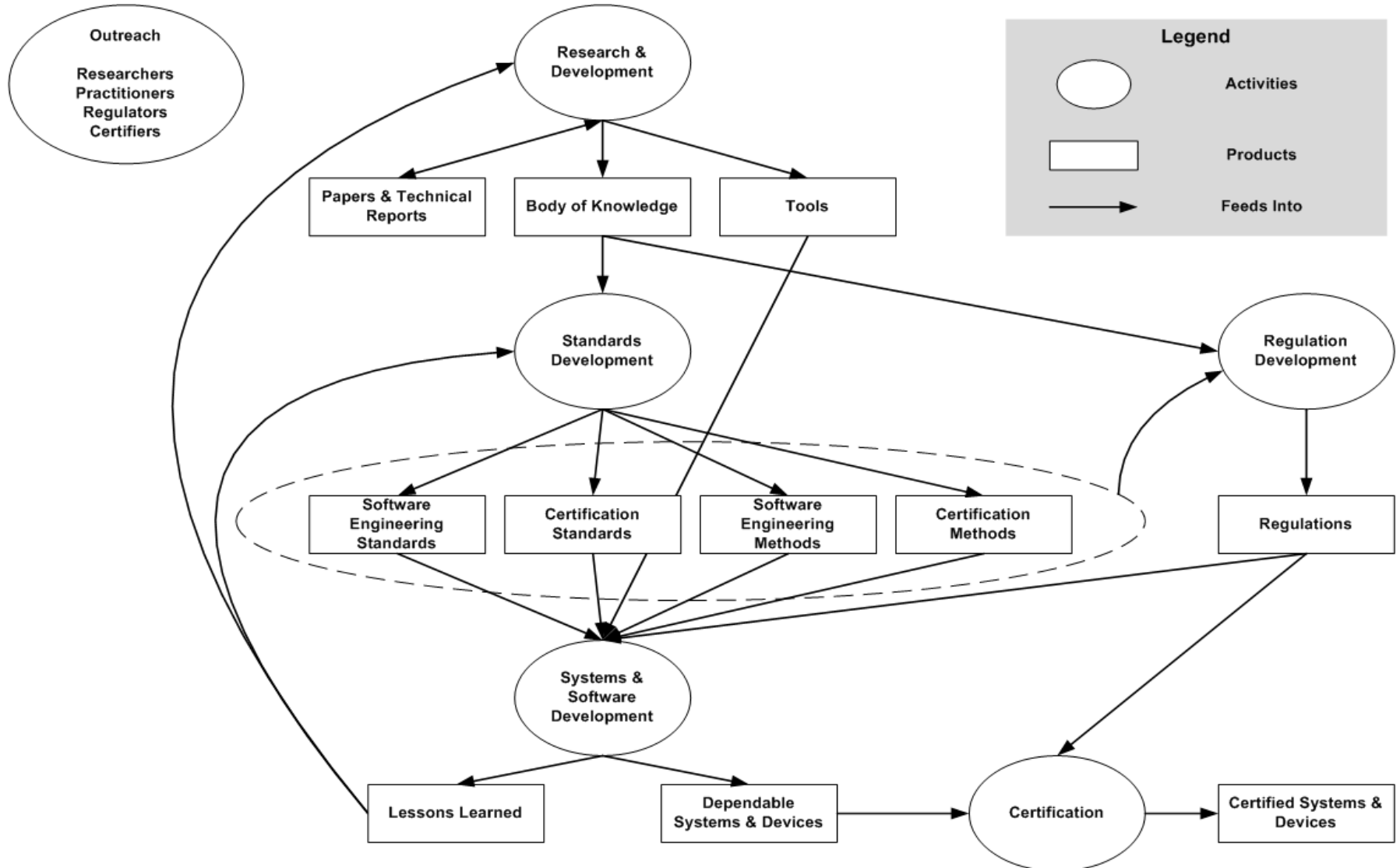

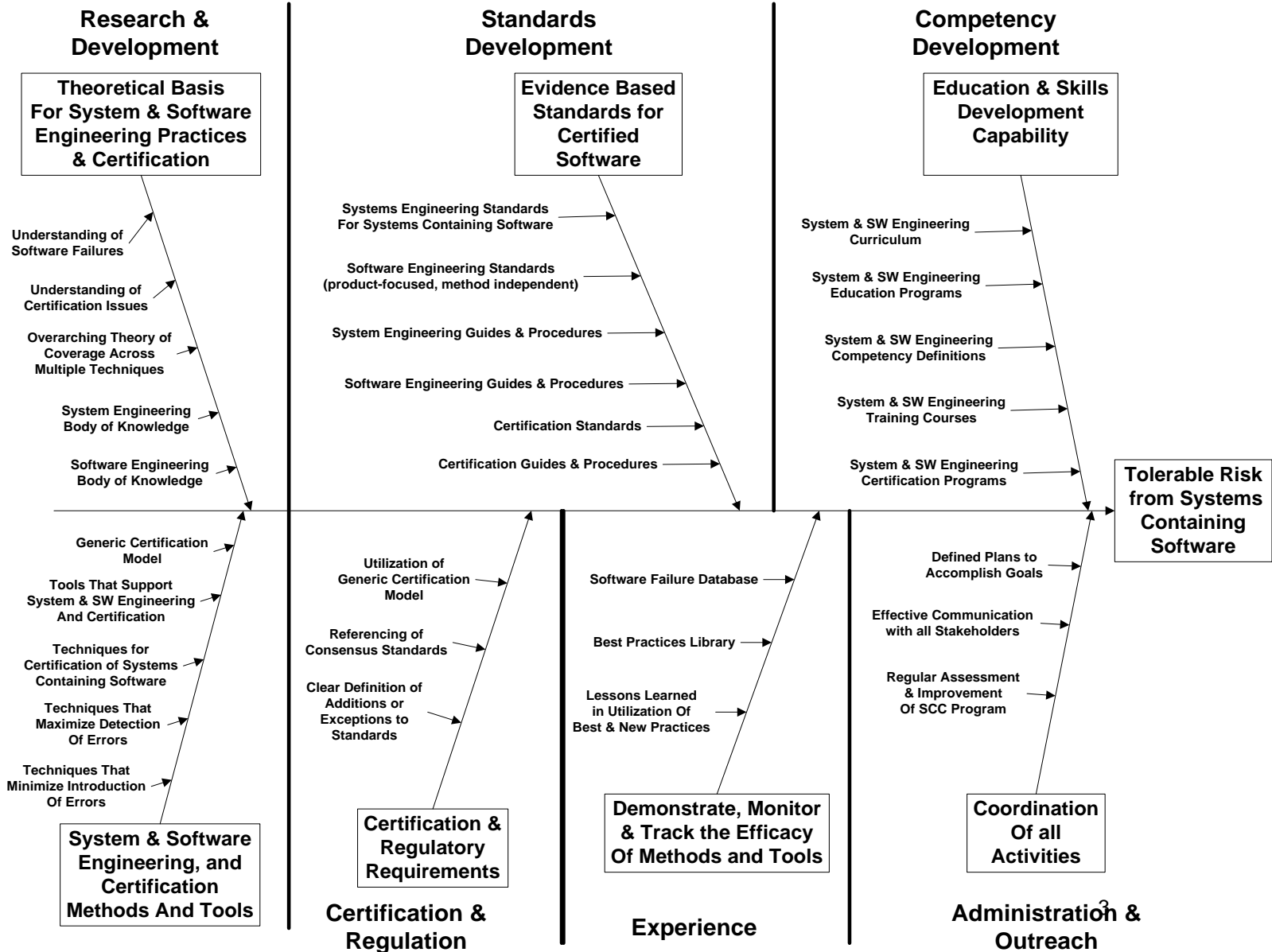

Scope & Deliverables



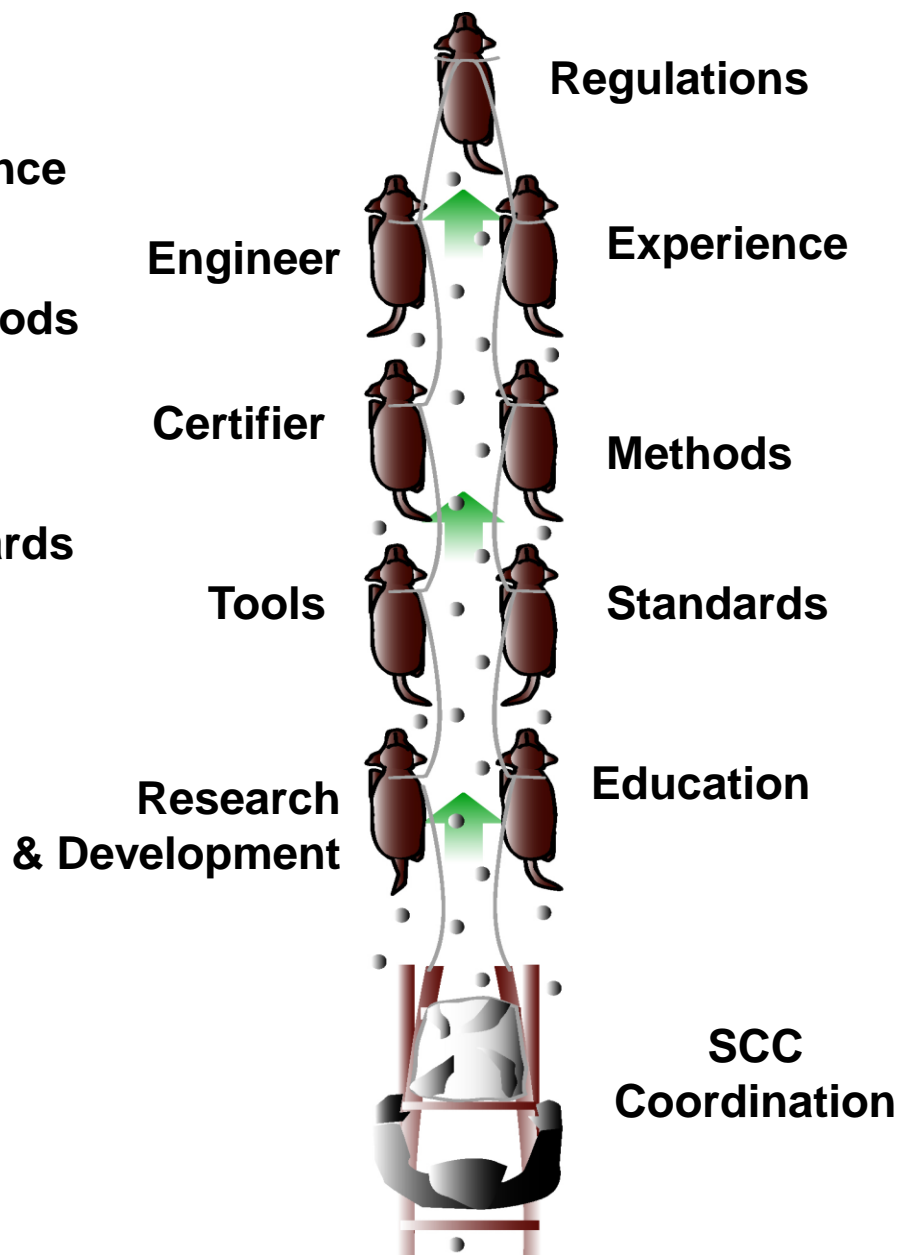
Overall Work Program Outcomes

Development of Two Year Plan

- Need to finalize the list of targeted outcomes proposed above
- SCC members need to identify existing work programs that contribute to the outcomes
- Form will be distributed to collect information on relevant existing work programs and their mapping to SCC targeted outcomes
- Collation and gap analysis to be presented at next meeting along with a proposed SCC two year work program

Funding

- McMaster Center for Software Certification will fund much of the administration and coordination efforts
 - Looking into funding sources for coordinative efforts – some sources required matching in-kind funding (such as costs associated with hosting SCC meeting)
 - Request will be sent out to SCC members to commit to hosting a future SCC workshop
- Core of work program accomplished through coordination and focusing existing work programs within:
 - Universities and research organizations,
 - Standards organizations, and
 - Companies involved in software development
- For work that is not within scope of any existing work programs, SCC will facilitate the appropriate partners in seeking funding
 - Looking into funding sources to support required work not currently funded
